Leader: The Confessional Lutheran Education Foundation International Lutheran Electronic Reader Project (the CLEF ILERP) can provide subscribing student, pastors, and professors with the potential of 2000 books and documents, including Bibles, commentaries, text books, course outlines, doctrinal papers, Biblical language books, catechisms, hymnals, lectionaries, liturgies, theological journals, sermons, and Bible studies on a CLEF Kindle Paper White.

All: ***Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19).***

Leader: This CLEF ILERP is presently operating in Ghana, Uganda, Nigeria, Kenya, Liberia, Central and South America, the Philippines, and the United States of America. The CLEF sends a qualified professor to teach an introductory course using the Kindle and assist the students in learning how to use the electronic reader. Wireless internet services are provided to them by CLEF.

All: ***Come, O children, listen to Me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord (Psalm 34:11).***

Leader: Most students and faculty live in homes that do not have space for books. This allows the library, with the latest technology and best theological materials, to be given to the seminaries and pastors. All resources, but especially God's Holy Scripture, are in one little book that can travel where ever they go. Kindles are automatically downloaded each time internet is accessed.
