Reader 1: Haiti is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and Ministry in Mission is the only Recognized Service Organization in Haiti working with the National Evangelical Lutheran Church in Haiti. Ted Krey, the Director of the Latin America District, offers seminary education for Haitian men desiring to serve existing churches and build new churches in Haiti.

Reader 2: This grant is a subsidy, not the total cost of seminary. It will be used for travel expenses to transport four seminarians to the Dominican Republic and back to Haiti, visas, school supplies, laptop computers, and general personal needs.

Reader 3: *And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers (Acts 2:42).*
