

## #1 Main Street Living Ministry Outreach TV Program \$4.998

- **Reader 1**: Main Street Living is a distinctly Lutheran worship service, featuring pastors and members from upper Midwest Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) congregations. Main Street is not intended to be a replacement for in-person worship but to provide a liturgical service to those who are unable to attend a local congregation.
- **Reader 2**: The video recording equipment that was purchased seven years ago for the South Dakota market needs updating to meet broadcast video quality standards. This \$4,998 grant will cover the cost of camera and equipment upgrades to assist in presenting a quality evangelistic television ministry that invites the unchurched and shut-ins to better know the saving grace of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
